SILT FENCE BARRIER

1. THE ORIGINAL TOPOGRAPHY, GROUND ELEVATION AND SURVEY DATA SHOWN ARE SUPPLIED FOR INFORMATION PURPOSES ONLY, AND IMPLY NO GUARANTEE OF ACCURACY. IT SHALL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR TO VERIFY ALL INFORMATION SHOWN.

- 2. THIS PLAN IS NOT A CADASTRAL SURVEY SHOWING LEGAL PROPERTY BOUNDARIES AND EASEMENTS. THE PROPERTY BOUNDARIES SHOWN HEREON HAVE BEEN DERIVED FROM INFORMATION SUPPLIED BY (OR SHOWN ON) ANNIS, O'SULLIVAN, VOLLEBEKK LTD. JOB NO. 23843-23 AND CANNOT BE RELIED UPON TO BE ACCURATE OR COMPLETE. THE PRECISE LOCATION OF THE CURRENT PROPERTY BOUNDARIES AND EASEMENTS CAN ONLY BE DETERMINED BY AN UP-TO-DATE LAND TITLES SEARCH AND A SUBSEQUENT CADASTRAL SURVEY PERFORMED AND CERTIFIED BY AN ONTARIO LAND SURVEYOR.
- 3. THE CONTRACTOR IS TO OBTAIN AND PAY FOR ALL NECESSARY PERMITS AND APPROVALS FROM THE CITY BEFORE COMMENCING CONSTRUCTION.
- 4. THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL LAYOUT.
- 5. THE CONTRACTOR IS TO DETERMINE THE EXACT LOCATION, SIZE, MATERIAL AND ELEVATION OF ALL EXISTING UTILITIES AND SERVICES PRIOR TO COMMENCING CONSTRUCTION. PROTECT AND ASSUME ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR EXISTING UTILITIES WHETHER OR NOT SHOWN ON THESE DRAWINGS. IF THERE IS ANY DISCREPANCY THE CONTRACTOR IS TO NOTIFY THE ENGINEER PROMPTLY.
- 6. RESTORE ALL EXCAVATIONS AND SURFACES OF PUBLIC ROAD ALLOWANCES TO CONDITION EQUAL OR BETTER THAN ORIGINAL CONDITION AND TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE CITY AUTHORITIES.
- 7. EXCAVATE AND DISPOSE OF ALL EXCESS EXCAVATED MATERIAL, SUCH AS ASPHALT, CURBING AND DEBRIS, OFF SITE AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER AND THE CITY.
- 8. ALL DISTURBED AREAS TO BE RESTORED TO ORIGINAL CONDITION OR BETTER UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED.

- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL TRAFFIC CONTROL AND SAFETY MEASURES DURING THE CONSTRUCTION PERIOD, INCLUDING THE SUPPLY. INSTALLATION, AND REMOVAL OF ALL NECESSARY SIGNAGE, DELINEATORS, MARKERS AND BARRIERS.
- 10. DO NOT ALTER GRADING OF THE SITE WITHOUT PRIOR APPROVAL OF THE
- . ALL ROADWAY, PARKING LOT, AND GRADING WORKS TO BE UNDERTAKEN IN ACCORDANCE WITH CITY STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS. THE CONTRACTOR IS TO PROVIDE POSITIVE DRAINAGE AWAY FROM THE BUILDING.
- 12. ALL DIMENSIONS AND INVERTS MUST BE VERIFIED PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION, IF THERE IS ANY DISCREPANCY THE CONTRACTOR IS TO NOTIFY THE ENGINEER
- 13. ELECTRICAL, GAS, TELEPHONE AND TELEVISION SERVICE LOCATIONS ARE SUBJECT TO THE INDIVIDUAL AGENCY:
- 13.1. ELECTRICAL SERVICE HYDRO ONE 13.2. GAS SERVICE - ENBRIDGE,
- 13.3. TELEPHONE SERVICE BELL CANADA, 13.4. TELEVISION SERVICE - ROGERS.
- 14. CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE TO COORDINATE ALL EXCAVATION WORK AROUND EXISTING UTILITIES AND SHALL PROTECT AND SUPPORT ANY UTILITY AND/OR SERVICE PER THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES. ALL WORK SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH CURRENT CODES AND STANDARDS OF APPROVAL AGENCIES HYDRO, BELL, ENBRIDGE, ROGERS AND THE CITY.
- 15. CONTRACTOR TO ENSURE ALL APPLICABLE OPS AND CITY OF OTTAWA SPECIFICATIONS ARE FOLLOWED DURING CONSTRUCTION

EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL NOTES

- THE CONTRACTOR IS TO INSTALL LIGHT-DUTY SILT FENCE BARRIER PER OPSD 219.110 ON ALL LEGAL BOUNDARIES OF THE SITE, AND SHALL PROTECT ALL CATCHBASINS AND OTHER STORM INLETS ADJACENT TO THE SITE WITH SEDIMENT TRAPS AND GEOTEXTILE BETWEEN THE FRAMES AND GRATES. GEOTEXTILE FOR SILT FENCE PER OPSS 1860, TABLE 3.
- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL IMPLEMENT BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES. TO PROVIDE FOR PROTECTION OF THE AREA DRAINAGE SYSTEM AND THE RECEIVING WATERCOURSE, DURING CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES. THIS INCLUDES LIMITING THE AMOUNT OF EXPOSED SOIL, TEMPORARY SEDIMENT INLET CONTROL DEVICES TO BE IMPLEMENTED DURING CONSTRUCTION ON ALL PROPOSED ROAD CATCHBASINS, REARYARD CATCHBASINS AND CATCHBASIN MANHOLES AND OTHER SEDIMENT TRAPS. NO RECYCLED GEOSOCK MATERIAL SHALL BE PERMITTED FOR USE ON SITE.
- AT THE DISCRETION OF THE PROJECT MANAGER OR COUNTY OF RENFREW, ADDITIONAL SILT CONTROL DEVICES SHALL BE INSTALLED AT DESIGNATED LOCATIONS.
- 4. EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPHS 4.1., and 4.2. BELOW, STABILIZATION MEASURES SHALL BE INITIATED AS SOON AS FEASIBLE IN PORTIONS OF THE SITE WHERE CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES HAVE TEMPORARILY OR PERMANENTLY CEASED, BUT IN NO CASE MORE THAN 14 DAYS AFTER THE CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY HAS TEMPORARILY OR PERMANENTLY CEASED. 4.1. WHERE THE INITIATION OF STABILIZATION MEASURES BY THE 14TH DAY AFTER CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY TEMPORARILY OR PERMANENTLY CEASE IS
- AS SOON AS FEASIBLE. 4.2. WHERE CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY WILL RESUME ON A PORTION OF THE SITE WITHIN 21 DAYS FROM WHEN ACTIVITIES CEASED. (E.G. THE TOTAL TIME PERIOD THAT CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY IS TEMPORARILY CEASED IS LESS THAN 21 DAYS) THEN STABILIZATION MEASURES DO NOT HAVE TO BE INITIATED ON THAT PORTION OF SITE BY THE 14TH DAY AFTER CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY TEMPORARILY CEASED.

PRECLUDED BY SNOW COVER, STABILIZATION MEASURES SHALL BE INITIATED

- 5. SEDIMENT THAT IS ACCUMULATED BY THE TEMPORARY EROSION AND SEDIMENT 10. ALL DISTURBED AREAS TO BE RESTORED TO ORIGINAL CONDITION OR BETTER CONTROL MEASURES SHALL BE REMOVED IN A MANNER THAT AVOIDS ESCAPE OF THE SEDIMENT TO THE DOWNSTREAM SIDE OF THE CONTROL MEASURE AND AVOIDS DAMAGE TO THE CONTROL MEASURE. SEDIMENT SHALL BE REMOVED TO THE LEVEL OF THE GRADE EXISTING AT THE TIME THE CONTROL MEASURE WAS
- CONSTRUCTED AND BE ACCORDING TO THE FOLLOWING: 5.1. FOR LIGHT-DUTY SEDIMENT BARRIERS, ACCUMULATED SEDIMENT SHALL BE REMOVED ONCE IT REACHES THE LESSER OF THE FOLLOWING: A DEPTH OF ONE-HALF THE EFFECTIVE HEIGHT OF THE CONTROL MEASURE. A DEPTH OF 300 MM IMMEDIATELY UPSTREAM OF THE CONTROL MEASURE. FOR ALL CONTROL MEASURES, ACCUMULATED SEDIMENT SHALL BE
- REMOVED AS NECESSARY TO PERFORM MAINTENANCE REPAIRS. 5.5. ACCUMULATED SEDIMENT SHALL BE REMOVED PRIOR TO THE REMOVAL OF
- THE CONTROL MEASURE. 5.6. ACCUMULATED SEDIMENT IS TO BE REMOVED AND DISPOSED OF AS PER
- 6. ALL TEMPORARY EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL MEASURES SHALL BE MONITORED TO ENSURE THEY ARE IN EFFECTIVE WORKING ORDER. THE CONDITION OF THE CONTROL MEASURES SHALL BE MONITORED PRIOR TO ANY FORECAST STORM EVENT AND FOLLOWING A STORM EVENT.
- 7. DUST CONTROL MEASURES SHOULD BE CONSIDERED PRIOR TO CLEARING AND GRADING. THE USE OF WATER, CALCIUM CHLORIDE FLAKES/SOLUTION OR MAGNESIUM CHLORIDE FLAKES/SOLUTION SHALL BE USED AS DUST SUPPRESSANTS AS PER OPSS 506. THIS IS TO LIMIT WIND EROSION OF SOILS WHICH MAY TRANSPORT SEDIMENTS OFFSITE, WHERE THEY MAY BE WASHED INTO THE RECEIVING WATER BY THE NEXT RAINSTORM.
- 8. ALL 'GREEN AREAS' TO BE TREATED WITH 150mm TOPSOIL AND SOD AS SOON AS FEASIBLE, AS PER OPSS 570.
- 9. TOPSOIL TO BE STRIPPED AND STOCKPILED FOR REHABILITATION. CLEAN FILL TO BE PLACED IN FILL AREAS AND COMPACTED TO 95% STANDARD PROCTOR DENSITY.

- UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED.
- 11. STOCKPILED MATERIAL IS TO BE STORED AWAY FROM POTENTIAL RECEIVERS (E.G. STORM CATCHBASINS, MAINTENANCE HOLES), AND BE SURROUNDED BY EROSION CONTROL MEASURES WHERE MATERIAL IS LEFT IN PLACE IN EXCESS OF 14 DAYS.
- 12. IF REQUIRED, DEWATERING/SETTLING BASINS SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED AS PER OPSD 219.240 AND LOCATED ON FLAT GRADE UPSTREAM OF OTHER EXISTING MITIGATION MEASURES. WATERCOURSES SHALL NOT BE DIVERTED, OR BLOCKED, AND TEMPORARY WATERCOURSES CROSSINGS SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUCTED OR UTILIZED, UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED IN THE CONTRACT, IF CLOSURE OF ANY PERMANENT WATER PASSAGE IS NECESSARY, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL RELEASE ANY STRANDED FISH TO THE OPEN PORTION OF THE WATERCOURSE WITHOUT
- 13. ALL EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL MEASURES SHALL CONFORM TO OPSS 577
- 14. WHERE DEWATERING IS REQUIRED, THE DISCHARGED WATER SHALL BE CONTROLLED IN ACCORDANCE WITH OPSS 518.
- 15. ALL SETTLING/FILTRATION BASINS SHALL BE EQUIPPED WITH TERRAFIX 27 OR GEOTEXTILE (OR APPROVED EQUIVALENT) AND SHALL BE CLEANED AND REPLACED

REMOVAL & REINSTATEMENT NOTES

EXISTING CONDITIONS OR BETTER.

1. THE CONTRACTOR IS TO REVIEW ALL EXISTING SITE CONDITIONS AND USE THEIR PROFESSIONAL JUDGEMENT TO DETERMINE THE EXACT LIMITS OF REINSTATEMENT OUTSIDE OF THE SITE LIMIT. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL MINIMIZE DISTURBANCE TO ALL ADJACENT PROPERTIES, AND SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE TO REINSTATE ALL AREAS DISTURBED BY CONSTRUCTION TO PRE-CONSTRUCTION CONDITION OR BETTER, AND BEAR THE COST OF THE SAME. ANY ADDITIONAL DAMAGE TO ADJACENT PROPERTIES OR SITE FEATURES CAUSED BY CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE REPAIRED AT THE COST OF THE CONTRACTOR TO

STRAWBALE CHECK DAM PER OPSD 219.180 IN REAR DITCH

- 2. ALL GROUND SURFACES SHALL BE EVENLY GRADED WITHOUT PONDING AREAS AND WITHOUT LOW POINTS EXCEPT WHERE APPROVED SWALE OR CATCH BASIN OUTLETS ARE PROVIDED.
- 3. CONTRACTOR TO ADJUST EXISTING CATCH BASINS, MANHOLES, FIRE HYDRANTS, VALVE CHAMBERS AND VALVE BOXES TO FINAL GRADE AS REQUIRED.
- 4. GRADING IN GRASSED AREAS WILL BE BETWEEN 2% TO 7%. GRADES IN EXCESS OF 7% WILL REQUIRE A MAXIMUM 3:1 TERRACING.




