A site visit revealed that there are no trees protected under the City of Ottawa Tree Protection Bylaw (2020-340) on this property. There are also no adjacent city trees, or trees greater than 10 cm on adjacent properties that will be significantly impacted by the development and therefore no Tree Conservation Report is required.

There are two small trees at the northwest corner in front of 300 Lisgar: one 16cm basswood (*Tilia americana*) and, directly behind it, a 10cm tree lilac (*Syringa reticulata*). These trees are approximately 1.5m from the corner of the subject property, and while some minor roots may be cut if excavation comes to the property line, the trees are not expected to be significantly impacted.
