The zoning amendment will make minor revisions to a section that applies city-wide.

PURPOSE AND EFFECT OF THE PROPOSED ZONING AMENDMENT

This is a city-initiated zoning amendment undertaken at the request of Council. Following flooding in 2019, Council directed planning to permit reconstruction of existing buildings and structures affected by flooding in accordance with flood-proofing standards and with permits issued by the Conservation Authorities without the need for minor variances.

The zoning by-law amendment report is anticipated to go to Planning Committee on October 24th, 2019, ARAC on November 7th, 2019, and City Council on November 13th 2019.
