SOIL SPECIFICATIONS

- 1. Topsoil Mix No. 1
 - 1.1. Use:
 - 1.1.1. For lawn foundation, seeding, and tree pits: use a mix composed by weight of 5% topsoil (black earth) and 95% screened loam.
 - 1.1.2. The topsoil must be composed of compost, sand, arable soil, and black earth, and must meet the following requirements:
 - Organic matter content: between 6% and 7%
 - pH: **between 6.0 and 7.0**
 - Cation exchange capacity (CEC): between 10 and 20 meq/100 g of soil
 - Phosphorus (P): ≥ 27 ppm
 - Potassium (K): ≥ 126 ppm
 - Magnesium (Mg): ≥ 151 ppm
 - Calcium (Ca): ≤ 4000 ppm
 - 1.1.3. Producing a finished surface free of:
 - .1. Debris and stones larger than **50 mm in diameter**;
 - .2. Coarse vegetal matter 10 mm in diameter and 100 mm in length, accounting for no more than 2% of soil volume;
 - .3 Consistency: friable soil when moist.

2. Topsoil - Mix No. 2

2.1. **Use:**

- 2.1.1. Planting beds for shrubs, perennials, and annuals.
- 2.1.2. The topsoil must be composed of compost, organic fertilizer, sand, arable soil, and black earth and must meet the following requirements:
 - Organic matter content: > 15%
 - pH: between 6.0 and 7.0
 - Cation exchange capacity (CEC): ≥ 10 and 20 meq/100 g of soil
 - Phosphorus (P): ≥ 67 ppm
 - Potassium (K): ≥ 134 ppm
 - Magnesium (Mg): ≥ 151 ppm
 - Calcium (Ca): **≥ 1001 ppm**
- 2.1.3. Producing a finished surface free of:
 - .1. Debris and stones larger than **50 mm in diameter**;
 - .2. Coarse vegetal matter 10 mm in diameter and 100 mm in length, accounting for no more than 2% of soil volume;
 - .3. Consistency: friable soil when moist.
