RE: TREE CONSERVATION REPORT – 7 TRISTAN COURT / 35 GIFFORD STREET

Dear Gino,

Since my last report regarding this site, dated January 10, 2020, a further tree has been added to the development envelope – a Norway maple (*Acer platanoides*). All other trees are still not relevant in terms of tree conservation reporting as they are either less than 10cm in diameter, and so are below the threshold set by the City of Ottawa’s Urban Tree Conservation By-law (By-law no. 2009-200), or are situated far enough away on adjacent property so their critical rooting zones will not be impacted by the proposed construction. Also, no trees are present on nearby city-owned land.

In terms of the maple tree, it is in good condition with an average diameter of 21cm (it is double stemmed at 0.3m from grade). The location of this tree is shown on the accompanying tree conservation plan and a picture is included on page 2 of this report. It is to be preserved and protected during construction.
